What is the Softball Super Series?

- The Softball Super Series (SSS#1) provides competition and development opportunities and pathways for players 19 years & under as well as coaches, game day managers, umpires and statisticians.
- The Softball Super Series supports the Pathway program.
- The SSS#1 will be conducted in two (2) divisions Male and Female.
- Double Round Robin + a Final Series.
- Games will be scheduled Wednesday nights and Sundays.
- The SSS Committee responsible for administration, development and promotion.

Who can participate in the SSS?

- All players including regional athletes are invited to nominate to participate in the SSS#1.
- A selection committee will review the nominations and invite players to participate in the tournament.
- Team Make-up
 - 12-16 players (each team will be permitted to have 2 senior players over 19, if required)
 - > 4 female and 4 male teams
 - Players will be placed/drafted into teams
- SSS#1 teams will not be permitted to train apart from the initial training session prior to the first round of the competition.
- Players to participate in 50% of round robin games to be eligible for finals.
- Double headers will be played on Sundays to allow regional players to participate.

Modified Rules

- Normal rules apply with the following inclusions:
- > A Double play will close the innings
- Runner starting at a different base each innings
 - > Top 2 & 5 runner starts at first
 - > Top 3 & 6 runner starts at second
 - > Top 4 & 7 runner starts at third

Offensive Power Plays

The Offensive Power Play occurs when one (1) defensive player is removed from the nominated innings. (Only one (1) Offensive Power Play per game per team)

Defensive Power Plays

> The Defensive Power Play occurs when each batter commences their start of bat with the count of strike one (1). (Only one (1) Defensive Power Play per game per team)
